Pool Rules

- Have fun!
- Dog(s) must be on leash outside and inside of facility (until safely in gated swim area). **Please do not use a retractable leash.** We have leashes to borrow inside if desired.
- Handlers (dog owners) must demonstrate adequate control over their dog(s) outside and inside the facility. Handler(s) are responsible for their dogs.
- Dog who are injured, are pre- or post-surgical, or are under a Veterinarian's care for any condition will need to submit a Veterinarian Clearance Form before swimming. (www.alaskak9aquatics.com)
- All appointments run on time. Rinsing and drying time are not included in the appt. time. Please exit the pool & the bath area in a timely manner for the convenience of the next customer.
- All dogs must bring documentation they are current on rabies vaccination or show veterinarian approval for lack thereof.
- All dogs should be current or titered for Parvo and Distemper or should have consulted with their veterinarian about lack thereof.
- All puppies must be two weeks past their second sets of shots. Please discuss your situation with staff if your puppy is unvaccinated prior to booking your orientation.
- Bordetella vaccine for kennel cough is suggested but not required.
- Please potty dogs prior to entering the facility, and clean up any messes. Let staff know so that we can deep clean also.
- **Please do not feed dogs at least 4 hours prior to swimming.**
- Owners and dogs must be non-aggressive to participate. Dogs that have space issues often can take advantage of a solo swim session, as the pool area is gated. Please discuss behavioral issues with staff. We *try* to accommodate all dogs.
- Please do not cut your dog's nails within two days of swimming unless they are also dremeled.
- Dogs that may not participate: those in heat, dogs with open wounds or infections or dogs that have had laryngeal paralysis surgery. Please do not bring a sick dog to the pool.
- Please coordinate with staff prior to appointment if your dog has urinary or bowel incontinence issues.
- Only 2 dogs per handler per appointment.
- If an altercation does occur between dogs, or you think your dog was injured on the premises please let the staff know immediately.

- **No tobacco or nicotine products are allowed inside our facility or in our parking lot. Such products are toxic to dogs. Please dispose of all such products properly off site.**
- No handlers under 16 years old. All handlers must sign Pool Rules. If a handler is under 18, then their legal guardian must sign hold harmless authorizing junior handler.
- All minors younger than 12 years old, must wear life jackets (provided) and may be required to sit on pool deck chairs for safety depending on circumstances. Handler(s) are 100% responsible for minors they bring. **PLEASE DO NOT BRING YOUR WONDERFUL YOUNG CHILDREN (under 12) TO YOUR ORIENTATION APPOINTMENT.** Please inform staff if you wish to bring young children to subsequent appointments, and how many you wish to bring. We often have reactive dogs on the premises and it might not be safe if we are not informed beforehand. We have limited life jackets available for children under 12.
- The facility has two dog washes, please use these prior to swimming if your dog is dirty.
- Please notify staff **immediately** if your dog has a potty accident in the swimming pool. Please allow your dog to finish if a poop accident does occur. A pile is easier to clean up than a trail! If an accident occurs elsewhere in the facility or parking lot, we have poop bags and poop trash cans throughout the facility. **If your dog poops in the pool, please stop swimming immediately and notify staff. Badly timed or big poops, especially diarrhea poops, may incur an additional swim fee if we have to deny service to the next swimmer due to cleaning.** We have a three strikes rule for pooping IN the pool unless your dog has known issues and you have disclosed such prior to booking an appointment.
- Alaska K9 Aquatics reserves the right to alter the pool rules as needed for the safe enjoyment of all participants. Refunds will be given if necessary for any pre-paid services.
- Alaska K9 Aquatics staff reserve the right to deny or end the session of any dog, including a dog that is ill, injured, showing aggression toward other dogs or humans, reacting with severe distress, or deemed to be needing veterinary approval to swim. We expect thoughtful, civil behavior from all humans on the premises

I understand the owners and staff of Alaska K9 Aquatics are not trained in veterinary medicine or physical therapy. They will help any participating dog swim to the best of that dog's ability. If you have any questions on the health of your dog please consult a veterinary doctor.

I knowingly and freely assume all risks associated with the activities described herein and assume full responsibility for my participation in the activities at the Alaska K9 Aquatics facilities. In consideration for being allowed to use the premises, I agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless Dog Planet Inc dba Alaska K9 Aquatics and Quality Investments 2 LLC, its directors, officers, employees, and agents from liability, loss or damage suffered by me or my dog arising out of the activities to be carried out on or around the Alaska K9 Aquatics facilities.
