- Dog(s) must be on leash outside and inside of facility (until safely in gated swim area). Please do not use a retractable leash. We have leashes to borrow inside if desired.
- Handlers (dog owners) must demonstrate adequate control over their dog(s) outside and inside the facility. **Handler(s) are responsible for their dogs**. Please pick up after your dog and alert staff to any accidents anywhere in the facility.
- Dog who are injured, are pre- or post-surgical, or are under a Veterinarian's care for any condition will need to submit a <u>Veterinarian Clearance Form</u> before swimming.
- All appointments last 58 minutes and are divided into 30 minutes pool time and 28 minutes in our self dog wash. If you think you will need more wash/dry time, please coordinate your request with staff prior to your appointment. Please exit the pool/deck **on time** for the convenience of our other clients.
- All dogs participating on first visit need to bring documentation they are current on rabies vaccination or veterinarian approval for lack thereof.
- All dogs should be current or titered for parvo and distemper or should have consulted with their veterinarian about lack thereof.
- All puppies must be one week past their second sets of shots, or owners should consult with their veterinarian to discuss lack thereof before entering facility.
- Bordetella vaccine for kennel cough is suggested but not required.
- Please potty dogs prior to entering the facility, and clean up any messes.
- Please do not feed dogs within 4 hours of swimming.
- Owners and dogs must be non-aggressive to participate. Dogs that have space issues often can benefit from solo swim sessions, as the pool area is gated. Please discuss any behavioral issues with staff prior to your appointment.
- Please do not cut your dog's nails within two days of swimming unless they are also dremeled.
- Dogs that may not participate: those in heat; dogs with open wounds or infections; or dogs that have had laryngeal paralysis surgery.

- We have a "3 strikes" rule for poop in the pool. Please coordinate with staff prior to your appointment if your dog has urinary or bowel incontinence issues. We will try to work with you to accommodate your special needs dog.
- Only 2 dogs per handler per appointment.
- If an altercation does occur between dogs, or you think your dog was injured on the premises, please let the staff know immediately.
- No handler under 16 years old. All handlers must sign Pool Rules. If a handler is under 18, then their legal guardian must sign hold harmless authorizing junior handler.
- All minors younger than 10 years old must wear lifejackets (provided) and <u>may</u> be required to sit on pool deck chairs for safety, depending on circumstances. Handler(s) are 100% responsible for minors they bring
- The facility has two dog washes. Please use these prior to swimming if your dog is dirty.
- Please notify staff immediately if your dog has a potty accident in the facility/swimming pool. Bags are positioned throughout the premises to facilitate any needed cleanups.
- Alaska K9 Aquatics reserves the right to alter the pool rules as needed for the safe enjoyment of all participants. Refunds will be given if necessary for any pre-paid services.
- Alaska K9 Aquatic staff reserve the right to deny or end the session of any dog, including a dog that is ill, injured, showing aggression toward other dogs or humans, reacting with severe distress, or deemed to need veterinary approval to swim.

I understand the owners and staff of Alaska K9 Aquatics are not trained in veterinary medicine or physical therapy. They will help any participating dog swim to the best of that dog's ability. If you have any questions on the health of your dog, please consult a veterinary doctor.

I knowingly and freely assume all risks associated with the activities described herein and assume full responsibility for my participation in the activities at the Alaska K9 Aquatics facilities.
